You may be in the midst of organizing, cleaning, and sneezing as we enter into the season of spring. Spring is my favorite season, watching everything grow, bloom, and come back to life. It's fitting that Easter comes the Sunday after the first full moon of Easter, with resurrection in the air.

Over the next few weeks, we will be looking at resurrection stories through the lectionary texts. The sermon series, "Casting Off," will focus on needs we have to caste off in efforts to grow. We know pruning helps bring back life. We may be pruning physically and spiritually.

I invite us to consider what we need to let go of in this season of spring cleaning. What do we need to let go of that weighs us down spiritually, that keeps us up at night? Are there burdens we need to release to our Lord?

Casting off is a reference to fishing as we are fishers in our discipleship found in Matthew 4:18-20. Casting off is also a reference to knitting as the Psalmist reminds us we are knit in our mother's womb (Psalm 139:13-14). We will learn together how the biblical stories relate to our own journeys being "cast off." Join us in worship and Sunday school as we grow together in Christ!

Come join us for a family retreat day at Camp Chestnut Ridge on April 20!


This free event includes:
