## PEOPLE OF THE WAY ARE PEOPLE *ON THE WAY*

*Jesus told him, "I AM THE WAY, the truth, and the life"... John 14:6 (NLT)*  
*I want to do what is good, but I don't. I don't want to do what is wrong,*  
*but I do it anyway. Romans 7:19 (NLT)*

*So we must listen very carefully to the truth we have heard, or we may*  
*drift away from it. Hebrews 2:1 (NLT)*

### HOW TO STAY ON THE WAY

*This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun! And all of this is a gift from God, who brought us back to himself through Christ. And God has given us this task of reconciling people to him. For God was in Christ, reconciling the world to himself, no longer counting people's sins against them. And he gave us this wonderful message of reconciliation. So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ. 2 Corinthians 5:17-21 (NLT)*

#### 1. Choose to learn and grow in HIS WAY.

*This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person... v. 17*

##### a. Learn His Way (Romans 12:1-2 & Ephesians 4:15)

b. Listen for His Way (John 14:26)

c. Live by His Way - faith, always faith (John 8:31-32)

2. Choose to embrace that life is going to change.

*The old life is gone; a new life has begun!* v.17

3. Choose to live for the "Then and There" instead of the "Here and Now".

*So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!"* v. 20

*Do not love this world nor the things it offers you, for when you love the world, you do not have the love of the Father in you. 1 Jn. 2:15 (NLT)*

*Store your treasures in heaven, where moths and rust cannot destroy, and thieves do not break in and steal. Matthew 6:20 (NLT)*

4. Choose to remember Him regularly and trust Him faithfully.

*For God made Christ, who never sinned, to be the offering for our sin, so that we could be made right with God through Christ.* v. 21

*"...Here on earth you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world." John 16:33 (NLT)*
