From the Pastor.

Away in a manger, no crib for his bed, the little Lord, Jesus, lay down his sweet head; the stars in the bright sky look down where he lay, the little Lord, Jesus, asleep on the hay.

ELW 277

You can hear the tune in your head, can't you? I know I can. What do you think of when you hear it? Perhaps standing in a church holding a hymnal open with a neighbor, or dressed up like a sheep singing in the Nativity play, Music is a great memory-holder. This time of year, we hear a lot of familiar songs that can bring back emotional memories. Hans Christian Anderson famously said, "Where words fail, music speaks". That's why characters break out in song in Broadway musicals — because their feelings are so big that simple dialogue just won't do. Music has an emotional power where spoken words fall short.

Saint Augustine is often credited with saying, "to sing is to pray twice," which is why it's unsurprising that in the Bible, people sing all the time. Most of the poems in the book of Psalms are songs God's people sang in worship or prayer, in desperation, anger, triumph, or praise. Hannah sings a song of thanksgiving when God answers her prayers and gives her a son, Samuel. Miriam sang a song of triumph and joy when the Hebrews escaped captivity by crossing the Red Sea. And Mary sang a song, The Magnificat, when her cousin Elizabeth rejoices with her for their miraculous pregnancies. It echoes Hannah's song:

- 46b"My soul magnifies the Lord,
- ⁴⁷ and my spirit rejoices in God my Savior,
- ⁴⁸ for he has looked with favor on the lowly state of his servant.
 - Surely from now on all generations will call me blessed,
- ⁴⁹ for the Mighty One has done great things for me, and holy is his name;
- ⁵⁰ indeed, his mercy is for those who fear him from generation to generation.
- 51 He has shown strength with his arm; he has scattered the proud in the imagination of their hearts.
- ⁵² He has brought down the powerful from their thrones and lifted up the lowly;
- ⁵³ he has filled the hungry with good things and sent the rich away empty.
- 54 He has come to the aid of his child Israel, in remembrance of his mercy,
- 55 according to the promise he made to our ancestors, to Abraham and to his descendants forever."

January 8, 2024.


