We could use a few more volunteers in the rotation for the sound booth at Bethel. If you would be willing to serve in this way, please contact James Timmerman.


The quilt blocks and towels are in the library ready to be embroidered. The work group needs the quilt blocks back by June 1st and the towels by July 1st.
