

Ainsworth EFC Gathering Plan for the Health Department:

Auditorium Space & Time:

- Chairs set up in rows spaced 6 ft apart, less than 75% capacity.
- People will be asked to leave 3 chairs between family groups.
- People are asked not to congregate during entry and exit, and meeting outside is encouraged while weather is nice.
- 2 services, 45 minutes each: 2 songs, prayer, preaching.
- Greeters/Ushers opening doors and assist with seating.
- HVAC fan is set to "on" instead of as needed.

Masks:

- We are encouraging mask wearing... although it is not mandatory, our focus is especially for entry, exit, singing, to care for and help others to avoid quarantine & keep meeting!
- Masks are available at the welcome desk.
- Hand Sanitizer stations are visible from main entry locations.

Cleaning:

- Hard surfaces are cleaned before and after the service.
- Restroom surfaces are wiped down between services.

Kids: *Currently there is no programming nursery – 8th Grade on Sunday Mornings . . . It is re-evaluated each week. When we do meet:

- Kids meet in a large room where chairs are distanced.
- Kids have their own supplies in baskets with names, will not be sharing with other children.
- No snacks will be served.
- Parents are asked to not bring children if they have a fever, symptoms of cold/flu, or not feeling well.
- Hand sanitizer available for children with adult supervision.

Other communication:

- Reminders to everyone before and at services not to come to the church if they are feeling sick in any way.
- Each week in the church email we will have a link to our plan and will add changes as needed.
- Visible reminder signs for 3-chair distance, encourage masks, and fellowship outside if possible.

***Exposure Plan:** If the church is contacted by the health department we will communicate relevant information with the church family via all-church email. We may also contact T-Group leaders to make contacts to people in their groups if necessary.
