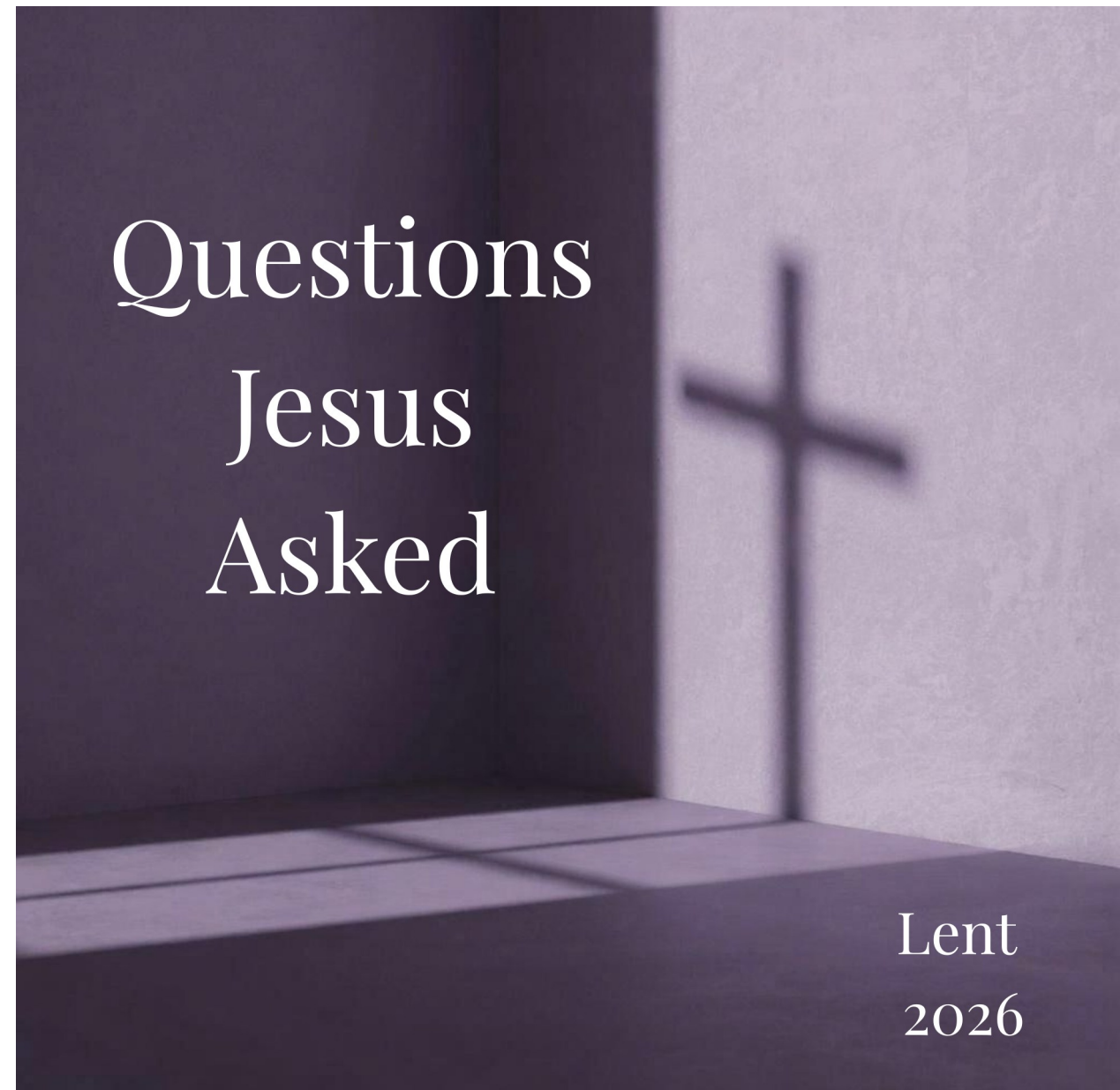
**Bob Fulks Being Honored By City Of Plant City**
